### The School of Nursing

- Original nursing program established in 1891
- Became an independent School of Nursing in 1941
- Ranked within the top Schools of Nursing in the U.S. across surveys
- Operates two nurse-managed primary care centers (North Campus Family Health Service and Community Family Health Center) and three outreach clinics (Maple Meadows Public Housing, SAFE House Domestic Violence Shelter, Ozone House Teen Shelter) serving 1,988 patients in 6,273 patient encounters (FY 2006)
- Funding Partners in two school based centers: East Middle School and Scarlett Middle School
- Access to three large Medical Centers locally, and numerous other health care institutions and agencies
- Offers curriculums leading to the following degrees:
  - ❖ Bachelor of Science in Nursing for non-nurses and registered nurse students
  - ❖ Master of Science in seven nursing programs: Nursing Business and Health Systems, Community Health Nursing, Gerontological Nursing, Medical-Surgical Nursing, Nursing Administration, Parent-Child Nursing, and Psychiatric-Mental Health Nursing
  - ❖ Doctoral Program in Nursing
  - ❖ Postdoctoral Fellowships in Health Promotion/ Risk Reduction, Biobehavior, and Women's Health Disparities
