SCHOOL OF NURSING COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

In an effort to better serve our students, the School of Nursing has partnered with CertifiedBackground.com to manage our students' health compliance documents. This is a robust management system which allows our students to meet the ever-evolving requirements of our clinical agencies.

CertifiedBackground.com is a service that allows students to purchase their own background check and manage their immunization records. The results of a background check are posted to the CertifiedBackground.com web site in a secure, tamper-proof environment, where the student, as well as School of Nursing representatives can view the background check and immunization records.

What does this partnership mean for you?

- a safe and secure way to upload and view your immunization records
- an easy and comprehensive way to complete your background check
- access to your health compliance documents electronically, 24/7
- information collected on CertifiedBackground.com will be available to you long after you graduate
- email reminders for those items you have not yet completed

NOTE: IT IS NO LONGER NECESSARY TO SEND COMPLIANCE DOCUMENTS TO THE SCHOOL OF NURSING.

School of Nursing Compliance Requirements are required for all clinical courses and courses with a community service learning component. Undergraduate students must provide COMPLETE documentation of the following requirements by the deadline: Requirement #1(a or b) Health and CPR certification, Requirement #2 Skills and abilities for Degree Completion, Requirement #3 Criminal Background Check .

Deadlines are the following:

Newly admitted or readmitted students:

Fall 2009 term: Monday, August 17, 2009

Continuing students:

Fall 2009 term: Monday, August 17, 2009

Winter 2010 term: Monday, December 21th, 2009

Spring/Summer 2010: Monday, April 26th, 2010

Failure to provide complete documentation by the deadlines noted will result in disenrollment from all the clinical courses and courses with the community service learning component.

Students are responsible for submitting/uploading all the compliance documentation to their accounts with CertifiedBackground.com.

Once the documents are uploaded into the students' accounts, the documentations will be checked for completeness and desired results. If the documentation are incomplete or do not arrive by the deadline:

- **Students will be disenrolled from any course requiring School of Nursing Compliance Requirements.**

HEALTH AND CPR CERTIFICATION INFORMATION

STATEMENT OF PHYSICAL FITNESS

Signature of physician or nurse stating the student is physically able to participate in the nursing program.

HEPATITIS B

- Date of first, second and third dose of vaccine, Or
- Positive Hepatitis B titer.

The Hepatitis B vaccine is a series of 3 doses. Please submit a copy of each dose *as you progress*.

MUMPS

- Date of first and second dose of vaccine (Pref. MMR) after 12 month of age Or,
- Positive Mumps titer.

RUBELLA (German Measles)

- Date of first and second dose of MMR after 12 months of age, Or
- Positive Rubella titer (greater than 10).

RUBEOLA (Hard or American Measles)

- Date of first and second dose of vaccine (Pref. MMR) after 12 month of age, Or
- Positive Rubeola titer (greater than 10).

TETANUS AND DIPHTHERIA

- Date of most recent booster

Boosters are good for 10 yrs from date of administration. Therefore you must have received your booster no earlier than 4/21/2000 to be valid thru next academic year.

TUBERCULIN

- Negative PPD

Current for one academic year from date of administration. Must be current thru 4/21/10.

PPD test needs to be updated every year.

VARICELLA ZOSTER (Chicken Pox)

- Date of first and second dose of vaccine, Or
- Positive Varicella titer.

The chicken pox vaccine requires 2 doses 4 - 8 weeks apart. Immunization records indicating "History of Disease" will not be acceptable.

CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION CERTIFICATION (CPR)

- CPR Certification for the Professional Rescuer or CPR for Health Care Provider.

CPR Certification is required to cover a minimum of one academic year, we strongly recommend a two year CPR certification. (Must be current thru 4/21/10. Second Career Program students must be current thru August 16, 2010).

- ___ TUBERCULIN (Must be current thru April 21, 2010)
- ___ VARICELLA (CHICKEN POX) (Vaccine ___ 1st dose ___ 2nd dose / Or ___ Positive Titer)
- ___ CPR CERT (CPR Certification for the Professional Rescuer or CPR for Health Care Provider. Must include infant, child and adult CPR certification. Must be current thru April 21, 2010. Second Career Program students must be current thru August 16, 2010)
- ___ SKILLS AND ABILITIES FOR DEGREE COMPLETION
