**NOTE:**

**UNDERGRADUATE CRITERIA:** Each undergraduate candidate for membership is required to meet the criteria for the undergraduate category of membership. Undergraduate students are required to have completed 1/2 of the nursing curriculum, have at least a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 grading scale and meet the expectation of academic integrity. Membership is offered in Fall term of senior year.

**GRADUATE CRITERIA:** Each graduate (master's or doctoral) candidate for membership is required to meet the criteria for the graduate category of membership. Master's and doctoral students are required to have completed 1/4 of the nursing curriculum. Students in the master's program are required to have achieved a 6.5 GPA on the Rackham grading scale. Students in the doctoral program are required to achieve a 7.0 GPA on the Rackham scale.
